JUNMAI DAIGINJO

Heiwa Shuzo | Kid Junmai daiginjo8 | 18

Wakayama Prefecture

Rice: Yamadanishiki | Polish: 50%

On the nose, delicate notes of green apple, melon and white flowers, while on the palate it is smooth and balanced, with a slight sweetness and lively acidity that makes it extremely versatile.

Emishiki | Sensation White7 | 16 | 58

Shiga Prefecture

Rice: Ginfubuki | Polish: 50%.

Floral and fruity aromas, with a round and velvety body, the finish, on the other hand, remains clean and persistent.

Senkin | Modern Omachi70

Tochigi Prefecture

Rice: Yamadanishiki and Omachi | Polish: 50 percent

Floral and citrus scents, elegant structure with a mineral finish.

JUNMAI GINJO

Heiwa Shuzo | Kid Junmai ginjo7 | 16 | 60

Wakayama Prefecture

Rice: Yamadanishiki and Gohyakumangoku | Polish: 50% - 55%.

Notes of peach and banana, crisp and slightly aromatic taste, with a clean and delicate finish.

Kikuzakari Shuzo | Onikenbai70

Iwate Prefecture

Rice: Local | Polish: 55%.

Aroma of yellow fruit and cereal, dry and firm taste, with character and beautiful persistence.

JUNMAI

Senkin | Organic Nature9 | 21 | 76

Tochigi Prefecture

Rice: Kamenoo (organic) | Polish: 90%

The Kimoto fermentation method and nondilution (Genshu) make it complex by imparting lactic, earthy and fresh fruit scents. The palate is deep and natural, reflecting the low polish of the rice.

FUTSUSHU

Tentakara Shuzo | Umakara6 | 13 | 50

Tochigi Prefecture

Rice: Gohyakumangoku and Asahiyume | Polish: 60%.

Simple and straightforward, light herbaceous notes and a dry, clean taste that makes it very versatile.

IN THE END

- Okihomare | Muromachi 90

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Shimane Prefecture
Rice: Shimane's Kaminomai | Polish: 90%.
Produced using a technique that dates back to around 1500, this sake is fermented using the ancient kimoto technique that imparts richness and complexity. Rich in umami, with hints of cooked rice and an enveloping texture reminiscent of older sake.
- Île Four | Ume

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Nara Prefecture
Category: Umeshu
Intense notes of Japanese plum, the finish is vibrant and thirst quenching. Balanced sweetness making it refreshing and pleasant.
- Tsuji Honten | Gozenshu Yuzushu

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Okayama Prefecture
Explosion of citrus on the nose and with a fragrant taste of yuzu; ideal as a digestive because of its freshness and aromaticity.
